

# **THE ENVIRONMENTAL PERMITTING (ENGLAND AND WALES) REGULATIONS 2016 (TRICOYA VENTURES UK LIMITED) EXERCISE OF FUNCTIONS DIRECTION 2018**

The Secretary of State gives the following Direction to the Environment Agency in exercise of the power conferred by regulation 33(1)(a) of the Environmental Permitting (England and Wales) Regulations 2016(a).

## **Citation and commencement**

**1.**—(1) This Direction may be cited as the Environmental Permitting (England and Wales) Regulations 2016 (Tricoya Ventures UK Limited) Exercise of Functions Direction 2018.

(2) It comes into force on **12 April 2018**.

## **Exercise of functions**

**2.**—(1) Functions under the Environmental Permitting (England and Wales) Regulations 2016 in relation to the relevant operation are exercisable by the Environment Agency for an indeterminate period, unless a further direction is issued under regulation 33(1).

(2) For the purposes of this Direction, “relevant operation” means the operation by Tricoya Ventures Limited (company registration no: 10087465) at the premises mentioned in the Schedule of a facility to manufacture acetylated wood elements which falls within paragraph (a) of Part A(2) of Section 6.6 of Chapter 6 of Part 2 of Schedule 1 to the Environmental Permitting (England and Wales) Regulations 2016.
