

BUSINESS STATEMENT

Mr Speaker, with permission I should like to make a short statement about this week's business.

The House awaits your decision on the SO24 application, Mr Speaker, but notwithstanding your decision, the House will no longer proceed with today's announced business.

The business for tomorrow will be as previously announced, General Debate on Anti-Semitism followed by debate on a motion on Redress for Victims of Banking Misconduct and the FCA. The business for Wednesday 18 April will now be the second reading of the Laser Misuse (Vehicles) Bill followed by a General Debate on Industrial Strategy. The Business for Thursday 19 April will remain as previously announced, namely Backbench Business Committee debates on surgical mesh and on cancer treatment.
