"All crimes recorded where the identified victim is aged over 65 for 2013, 2014, 2015, 2016, 2017 calender years, with an annual breakdown.

The number of such crimes that resulted in a prosecutions over the same years, with a similar breakdown.

If possible, could you please categorise the reports by detail of the crime."

A search for information has now been completed by the Ministry of Defence Police and I can confirm that we do hold information in scope of your request.
