I am writing to inform you of the Government's view of the position of Gateway Sixth Form College, in the light of Further Education (FE) Commissioner and Education and Skills Funding Agency (ESFA) monitoring, since the Commissioner's initial intervention assessment in November 2016.

Following a recent inspection by Ofsted, I am encouraged to note that Gateway Sixth Form College has now been re-assessed and has received an improved Ofsted grading of 'Requires Improvement'. I am therefore bringing Gateway Sixth Form College, out of FE Commissioner Intervention.

I now look to you and the Principal to ensure that the quality of provision continues to improve in order to provide good quality provision for the learners in your community.
