1. The Respondent's application to strike out the claims as having no reasonable prospects of success is refused.

3. The claims of unfair dismissal of both Claimants have little reasonable prospect of success and both Claimants are ordered to each pay a deposit of £100 as a condition of continuing with that claim, by the 6 June 2018.
