A new runway at Heathrow and Wales

A new runway at Heathrow would bring real benefits to people across Wales

- It would mean there is more room for flights from airports across the UK to Heathrow and connections with its long-haul destinations.
- It would also mean a greater choice of airlines at Heathrow and international destinations for people going on holiday, visiting friends or family or travelling for business.

Expansion would send a clear message to the world that Britain is a truly global nation

- It would ensure we have the connections we need to thrive internationally.
- A new runway would enable Heathrow to nearly double its capability to move cargo by air, offering businesses across **Wales** the chance to increase their exports.

- Heathrow already has **superior road and rail connections** with the rest of the UK.
- Western Rail Link is planned to allow a faster rail route for passengers travelling to Heathrow from South Wales without having to go into London. The scheme is currently being designed in detail before Network Rail starts its own planning process.
- The **M4** will be upgraded between junctions 3 and 12 to provide additional capacity and better operational performance.
- Additional capacity at Heathrow would support growth in important sectors of the UK and **the Welsh economy**, such as advanced manufacturing, financial and professional services and the creative industries.
