N.B. the term 'sexual misconduct' here covers sexual harassment, sexual assault, rape, stalking and/or other forms of gender violence, including domestic violence, and any other unwelcome behavior of a sexual nature that is committed without consent or by force, intimidation, coercion, or manipulation.

We have handled your request under the Freedom of Information Act 2000.

There have been no allegations of sexual harassment, sexual assault, rape, stalking or other gender based violence from Wales Office staff from 1 January 2013 – 5 March 2018. Consequently, there have been no formal complaints or investigations, financial settlements awarded to staff for making allegations, members of staff who have changed jobs after making allegations or any non-disclosure agreements.

The Wales Office is not an employer in its own right, staff are employed under Ministry of Justice contracts. We therefore follow Ministry of Justice non-disclosure policies. You may wish to ask them for the information you have requested.
