



# Returning from West Africa? Information about Ebola

## There is a large Ebola outbreak going on at present in West Africa

The risk of Ebola is low for most travellers.

If you have been in Sierra Leone, Guinea or Liberia in the last **21 days** tell passport control in order to access advice and support on Ebola. This is important so we can offer you appropriate expert advice.

To access this advice:

- go to a manned passport desk and tell the staff when you present your passport that you have been to one of the affected countries Sierra Leone, Guinea or Liberia within the last 21 days
- you will be passed to a public health team who will provide appropriate advice and support
- this will include filling in a brief questionnaire that your airline may have already provided. If not, the team will provide you with one
- this process will only take a short time to ensure minimal inconvenience
