JUDGMENT

1. The claimant's claim for discrimination in respect of the last act (namely dismissal with an effective date of termination of 25th May 2016) is out of time but it would be just and equitable to extend time.
2. The decision as to whether other acts/omissions complained of are part of a continuing act (and if not whether it is just and equitable to extend time on these matters) is a matter for the Tribunal at the final hearing.
