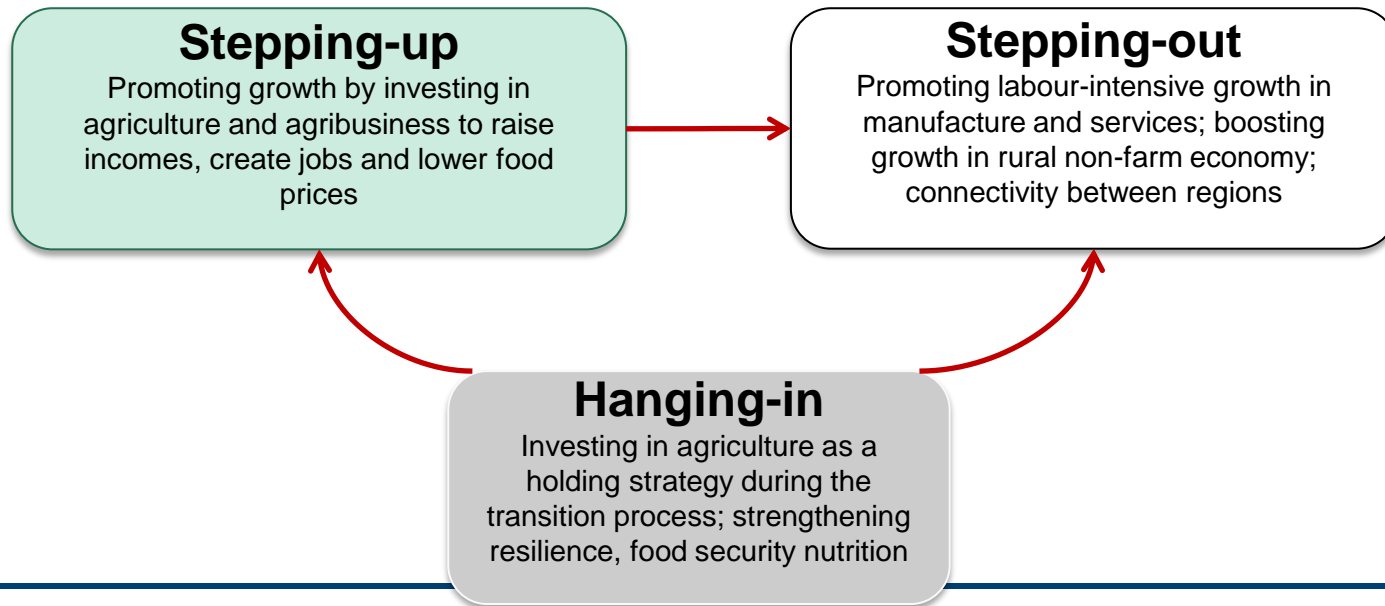


DfID's Approach to Agriculture and Economic Development

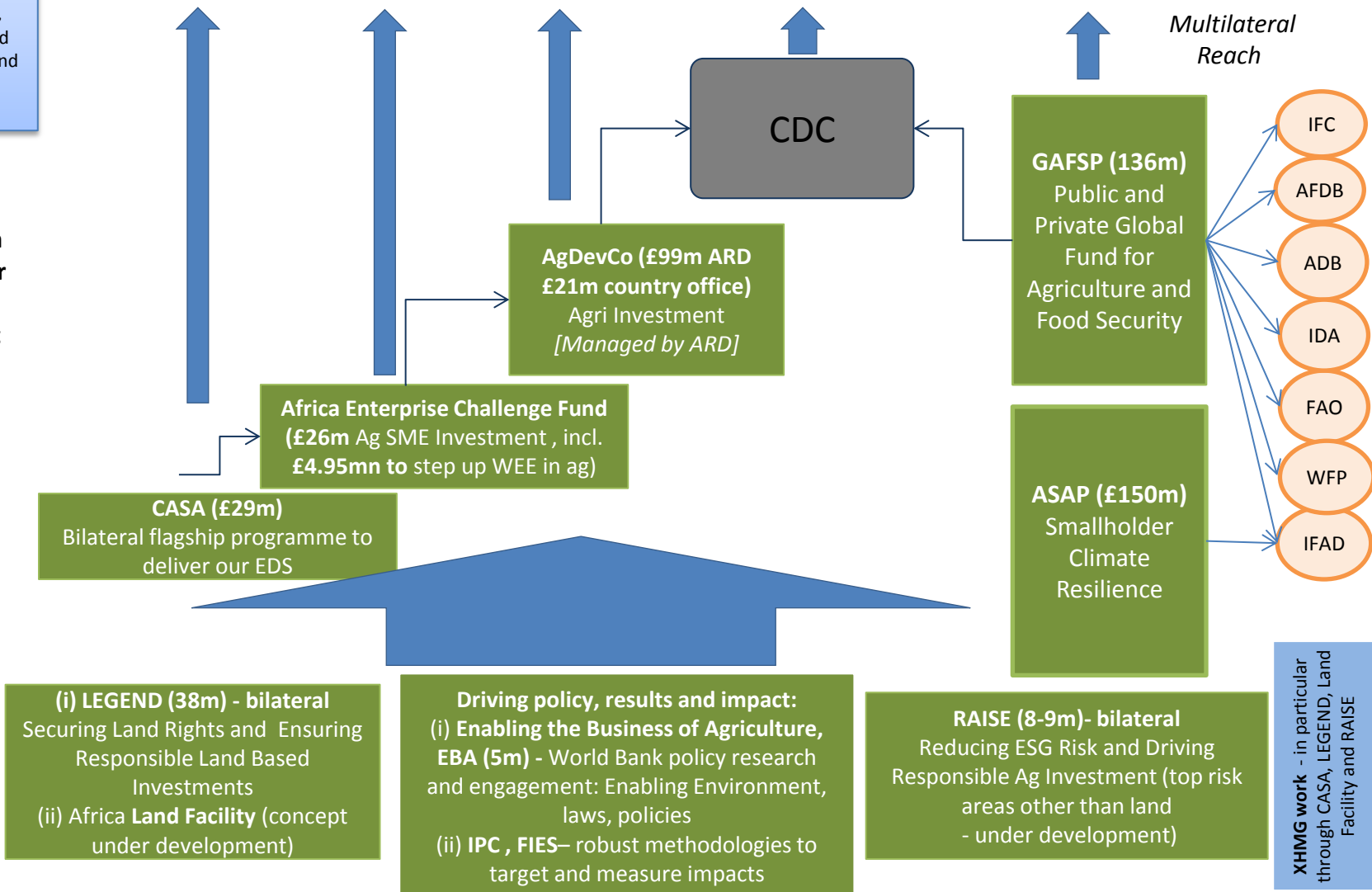


Geographic footprint:
