**The Feed-in Tariffs and Contracts for Difference (Amendment)
(EU Exit) Regulations 2018**

The requirements of paragraph 3(2) of Schedule 7 to the European Union (Withdrawal) Act 2018(a) (relating to the appropriate Parliamentary procedure for these Regulations) have been satisfied.

The Secretary of State makes these Regulations in exercise of the powers conferred by section 8 of that Act(b).

Citation and commencement

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Feed-in Tariffs and Contracts for Difference (Amendment) (EU Exit) Regulations 2018 and come into force on exit day.

Amendment of the Feed-in Tariffs Order 2012

2. In article 27(6) of the Feed-in Tariffs Order 2012(c), in paragraph (b) of the definition of “qualifying renewable electricity”, omit “other than the United Kingdom”.

Amendment of the Electricity Supplier Obligations (Amendment & Excluded Electricity) Regulations 2015

3. In regulation 3(3)(b) of the Electricity Supplier Obligations (Amendment & Excluded Electricity) Regulations 2015(d), omit “other than the United Kingdom”.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Regulations)

These Regulations are made in exercise of the powers conferred by section 8 of the European Union (Withdrawal) Act 2018 in order to address failures of retained EU law to operate effectively and other deficiencies arising from the withdrawal of the United Kingdom from the European Union. These Regulations amend the Feed-in Tariffs Order 2012 and the Electricity Supplier Obligations (Amendment & Excluded Electricity) Regulations 2015, to reflect the fact that the United Kingdom will not be a member State of the EU following the United Kingdom's withdrawal from the EU.
