### Description of works

Erection of a temporary fence around a pond to prevent grazing cattle from spreading the invasive weed infesting the pond into the adjacent mire. The fence will be enclosing an area of 0.04ha, and will be 3 strands of barbed wire, with a stile to allow public access. It will be in a place a maximum of 5 years while we undertake a project to manage the invasive New Zealand pygmyweed, Parrot's feather and Canadian pond weed.
