

Declaration of Exempt Works

Description of works

Surrey Wildlife Trust is erecting temporary electric fencing to contain cattle for conservation grazing to increase the biodiversity interest of Broadstreet Common, for no longer than a period of six months.

The fenced areas are part of Common Land unit CL46, the temporary fencing will enclose an area less than 10 Hectares. The temporary fencing will be erected on the 5th June 2018.
