JUDGMENT

1. The claim for outstanding holiday pay is well founded. The respondent is ordered to pay the claimant compensation of **£845.96**. This is a net sum and not liable for any deductions.
2. The respondent failed to provide the claimant with written particulars of employment. By virtue of Section 38 of the Employment Act 2002 the tribunal also considers it just and equitable to make an award of an amount equal to four weeks' pay, namely **£1,280.00**. This sum is not liable for further adjustment.
