JUDGMENT

1. The claimant's claim for unpaid wages for March and April 2017 succeeds and is upheld. The respondent is ordered to pay to the claimant the net amount of £2,452.50. In addition, the respondent is ordered to pay to the claimant £15 bank charges incurred because of the failure to pay the claimant's wages.
2. The claimant's claim for notice pay of one week is upheld. The respondent is ordered to pay to the claimant the net amount of £450.
3. The claimant's claim for outstanding holiday is upheld. The respondent is ordered to pay to the claimant the net amount of £270.
4. The total payable by the respondent to the claimant is £3,187.50.
