**DECISION NOTICE: APPLICATION BY THE CHARTERED INSTITUTE OF LEGAL EXECUTIVES TO
BE DESIGNATED AS A LICENSING AUTHORITY**

I received a recommendation last month from the Legal Services Board (LSB) that I make an Order to designate the Chartered Institute of Legal Executives (CILEX) as a licensing authority under the Legal Services Act 2007 for the following reserved legal activities: the exercise of a right of audience; the conduct of litigation; reserved instrument activities; probate activities; and the administration of oaths.

I have decided to make an Order to this effect under paragraph 15 of Schedule 10 to the Legal Services Act 2007 to designate CILEX as a licensing authority. The Order will be laid in Parliament in due course and my officials will keep you in touch with progress.
