Within the local area of the proposed UTC, it is expected that 2 colleges would feel a minimal impact, 5 colleges would feel a moderate impact and no colleges would feel a high impact when the UTC opens.

Conclusion

Overall, the unique nature of the UTC reduces the competition with individual schools and colleges. The UTC will be relatively small in comparison to existing provider and given the large catchment area, the UTC should not attract large numbers of students from any one school. The LA is supportive of the UTC and acknowledges that it has the potential to increase local educational diversity and parent and student choice. In the light of the evidence available, officials see no reason why the Secretary of State should not enter into a supplemental funding agreement with the academy trust as a result of negative impact.
