

## Scott Medical and Healthcare College - Impact Assessment

As required under section 9 of the Academies Act 2010, we have assessed the likely impact of opening the free school on other schools in the area where the school is to be located. The assessment shows there are 12 secondary schools within 2.1 miles of Scott College and 3 colleges within 27.8 miles of Scott College. It is expected that there will be some impact on pupil numbers at a number of schools in the local area, in particular UTC Plymouth and All Saints Church of England Academy. However, we do not expect the long term viability of the majority of schools to be affected. The studio school will be small in capacity and is likely to attract pupils from outside a wide geographical area, not Plymouth city alone. Furthermore, the studio school's specialism will provide additional choice for parents.
