# THE TIME FOR PRESENTING A RESPONSE HAVING EXPIRED AND NO VALID RESPONSE HAVING BEEN PRESENTED

### **JUDGMENT UNDER RULE 21**

- 1. The claimant's claims against the first and second respondents are dismissed because these respondents do not appear to be legal entities; and
- 2. The Claimant's claims against the third respondent are dismissed upon withdrawal by the claimant; and
- 3. The claimant was unfairly dismissed by the fourth respondent; and
- 4. The claimant's claim for breach of contract succeeds against the fourth respondent in respect of his notice pay; and
- 5. The claimant's claim for unlawful deduction from wages succeeds against the fourth respondent; and
- 6. The claimant's claim for accrued but unpaid holiday pay succeeds against the fourth respondent; and
- 7. The hearing listed for 27, 28 and 29 June 2018 is cancelled; and
- 8. The appropriate remedy to be met by the fourth respondent will be determined at a hearing notice of which is attached.
