

Consent under section 72(3C) of the Enterprise Act 2002 to certain actions for the purposes of the Initial Enforcement Order made by the Competition and Markets Authority ('CMA') on 18 June 2018

Completed acquisition by CD&R Firefly Bidco Limited of LSF9 Robin Topco Limited

We refer to your emails and submissions dated 9 May 2018, 15 May 2016, 6 June 2018, 9 July 2018 and 20 July 2018 requesting that the CMA consents to derogations to the Initial Enforcement Order of 18 June 2018 (the 'Initial Order'). The terms defined in the Initial Order have the same meaning in this letter.

Under the Initial Order, save for written consent by the CMA, CD&R and CD&R Firefly Bidco are required to hold separate the LSF9 Robin business from the CD&R business and refrain from taking any action which might prejudice a reference under section 22 of the Act or impede the taking of any remedial action following such a reference. After due consideration of your request for derogations from the Initial Order, based on the information received from you and in the particular circumstances of this case, CD&R and CD&R Firefly Bidco may carry out the following actions, in respect of the specific paragraphs:

1. Paragraphs 5(a), 6(a), 6(f) and 6(l) of the Initial Order

During the specified period (as defined in the Order), to ensure that MRH Ltd ("MRH", a wholly owned subsidiary of LSF9 Robin Topco Limited) is maintained as a going concern and that the value of the business is maintained, and to ensure compliance with relevant legal and regulatory requirements, Motor Fuel Group ("MFG", a wholly owned subsidiary of CD&R Firefly Bidco Limited) will update (including through the development and use of parallel Sage 2 and DRS 2 software systems) relevant back office and accounting functions of MRH.

The following MFG staff will provide training and technical support to MRH staff on these systems: [X] (Director, MFG Financial Control), [X] (Reconciliation and Analysis Manager) and [X] (Reconciliation Analyst). These individuals will be subject to NDAs in a form approved by the CMA.
