Suspected and laboratory-confirmed reported norovirus outbreaks in hospitals: outbreaks occurring in weeks 22 to 26, 2018

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Suspected and laboratory confirmed reported norovirus outbreaks in hospitals: outbreaks occurring in weeks 22 to 26, 2018 (England)

The hospital norovirus outbreak reporting scheme (HNORS) recorded eight outbreaks occurring between weeks 22 and 26 2018, all of which led to ward/bay closures or restriction to admissions and four of which (50 per cent) were recorded as laboratory confirmed due to norovirus. From week 01 (week beginning 1 January 2018) to week 26 (week beginning 25 June 2018), 252 outbreaks have been reported. Ninety-six per cent (243) of reported outbreaks resulted in ward/bay closures or restrictions to admissions and seventy-two per cent (182) were laboratory confirmed as due to norovirus.


Norovirus laboratory reporting: data from SGSS (England and Wales)

From week 01, 2018 to week 26, 2018 there were 4094 laboratory reports of norovirus. This is 2 per cent lower than the average number of laboratory reports for the same period in the seasons between 2013 and 2017 (4197).

Note: Data from laboratory reporting are subject to a reporting delay and the number reported in the most recent weeks is likely to rise as further laboratory reports are received.


