Notice is hereby given that the above referenced Order has been submitted to the Secretary of State for Environment, Food and Rural Affairs for determination. An Inspector will be appointed by the Secretary of State to determine the Order.

The **start date** for the above Order is **24 July 2018**.

Consideration of the Order will take the form of exchanges of statements of case and comments on statements of case.

The effect of the Order, if confirmed without modifications, will be to extinguish the public footpath running from point B (OS reference number SK 57676311) The Mount, Newlands, Mansfield Woodhouse to point A (OS reference number SK 57636316) Clipstone Drive, Newlands, Mansfield Woodhouse as shown on the order map.

Timetable for sending in statements of case and comments

Within 2 weeks of the start date [by 7 August 2018]

The Order Making Authority must ensure their statement of case is received by the Secretary of State. As soon as possible after the deadline, the Secretary of State will send a copy (excluding copies of any supporting documents - these will be available to view at the Authority's offices) to everyone who has made an objection or representation, the applicant and any other person who has written to us in respect of the Order.

Within 8 weeks of the start date [by 18 September 2018]

Everyone who has made an objection or representation or any other written representation must ensure their statement of case is received by

the Secretary of State. As soon as possible after the deadline, the Secretary of State will send full copies to the Authority. Copies (excluding copies of any supporting documents - these will be available to view at the Authority's offices) will also be sent to the applicant, every person who has made an objection or representation and any other person who has written to us in respect of the Order.

Within the same period the applicant (if applicable) must ensure their statement of case is received by the Secretary of State. As soon as possible after the deadline, Secretary of State will send a full copy to the Authority. Copies will also be sent to everyone who has made an objection or representation and any other person who has written to us in respect of the Order (excluding copies of any supporting documents - these will be available to view at the Authority's offices).

Within 14 weeks of the start date [by 30 October 2018]

Everyone who has made an objection or representation, the Authority, the applicant (if applicable) and anyone who has written to us in respect of the Order must ensure that their comments on any or every other statement of case is received by the Secretary of State. As soon as possible after the deadline, the Secretary of State will send copies of these comments to everyone else.

Any other person wishing to make representations in writing to the Secretary of State in respect of the above Order must do so in line with the timetable set out above.

In fairness to the other parties everyone should keep to the timetable to ensure that statements of case and comments are received on time. Late documents will be returned.

We cannot accept any libellous, racist or abusive comments. Any documents containing such comments will be returned.

PUBLIC PATH EXTINGUISHMENT ORDER

This Order is made by Mansfield District Council ("the authority") under section 118 of the Highways Act 1980 ("the 1980 Act") because it appears to the authority that the footpath described below is not needed for public use.

The Nottinghamshire County Council have been consulted as required by Section 120(2) of the 1980 Act.

BY THIS ORDER:

The public right of way over the land situated between The Mount and Clipstone Drive, Newlands, Mansfield, Nottinghamshire and shown by a continuous bold red line on the map attached to this Order and described in the Schedule to this Order shall be extinguished after 28 days from the date of confirmation of this Order.

SCHEDULE

The footpath running from point B (OS reference number SK 57676311) The Mount, Newlands, Mansfield Woodhouse to point A (OS reference number SK 57636316) Clipstone Drive, Newlands, Mansfield Woodhouse. The footpath is approximately 66 metres in length and is between 1.5 and 4.05 metres in width.

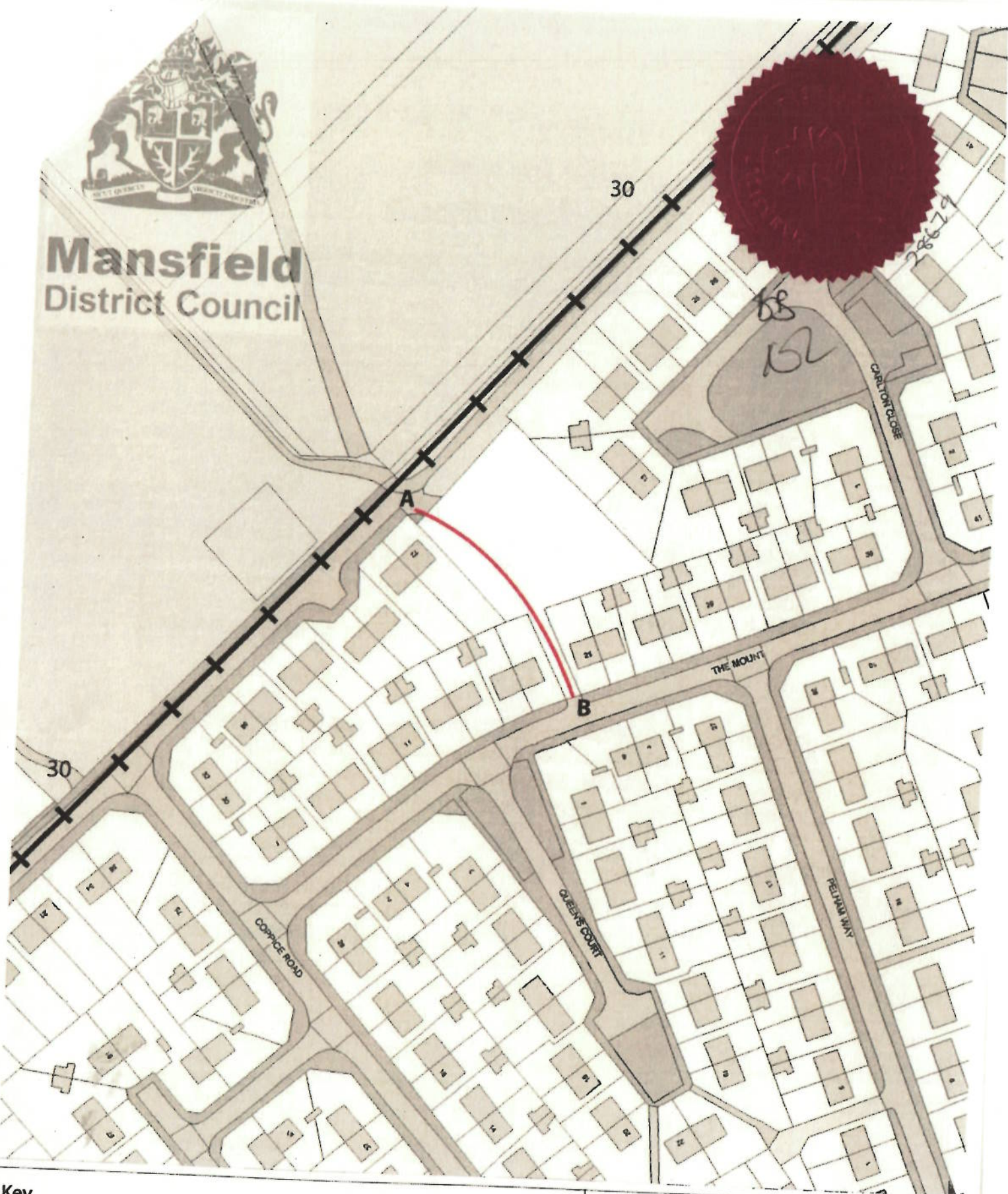
