- 2. After hearing some further evidence that morning, at 11.02 am, the parties asked the Tribunal for time to consider whether terms of settlement could be agreed. Such time was afforded. The parties reached agreement and invited the Tribunal to

stay the proceedings to allow them to implement its terms. That was done in accordance with this Tribunal's customary procedure.
