- 1. The Claimant's unauthorised deductions of wages claims is well-founded and the Respondent is ordered to pay them the sum of £1,508.33.

- 3. The Claimant's wrongful dismissal claim has been proved and the Respondent is ordered to pay them the sum of £1,287.04 net.
