JUDGMENT

Employment Tribunals Rules of Procedure 2013 – Rule 21

Mr Dermot Whelan

1. The Claimant's unauthorised deductions of wages claims is well-founded and the Respondent is ordered to pay them the sum of **£1,508.33**.
2. The Claimant's breach of contract claims in respect of accrued unpaid holiday is well-founded and the Respondent is ordered to pay them the sum of **£527.91 gross**.
3. The Claimant's wrongful dismissal claim has been proved and the Respondent is ordered to pay them the sum of **£1,287.04 net**.
4. The application to amend by adding a claim for a redundancy payment is granted and the respondent is ordered to pay the claimant the sum of **£7,918.68**.
5. The total sum to be paid to the claimant is **£11,241.96**.
6. The Claimant shall account for any income tax and national insurance deductions on the stated sums.
