JUDGMENT

That part of the claimant's claim which relates to the terms and conditions of his employment as a retained firefighter is struck out.

REASONS

- 1. By letters dated 20 and 28 February 2018 the Tribunal gave the claimant's Personal Representative an opportunity to make representations or to request a hearing, as to why the claim for terms and conditions should not be struck out because it has not been actively pursued.
- 2. The claimant's Personal Representative has failed to make representations in writing, or has failed to make any sufficient representations, why this should not be done or to request a hearing. The claim for terms and condition is therefore struck out.
- 3. That part of the claimant's claim which relates to pension entitlement is stayed pending further order.
