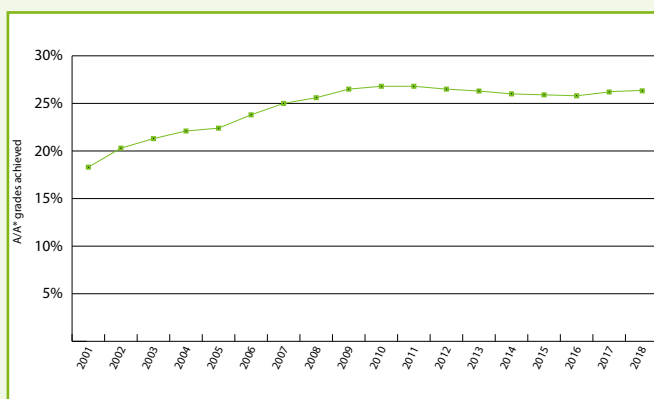

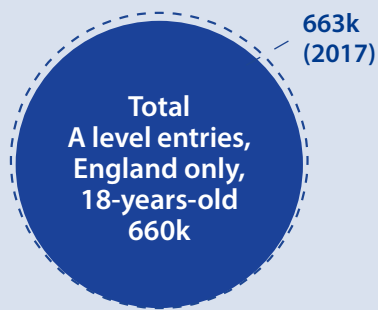

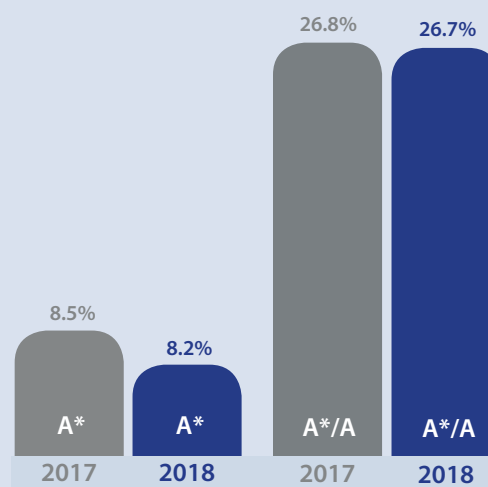

England only, 18-years-old



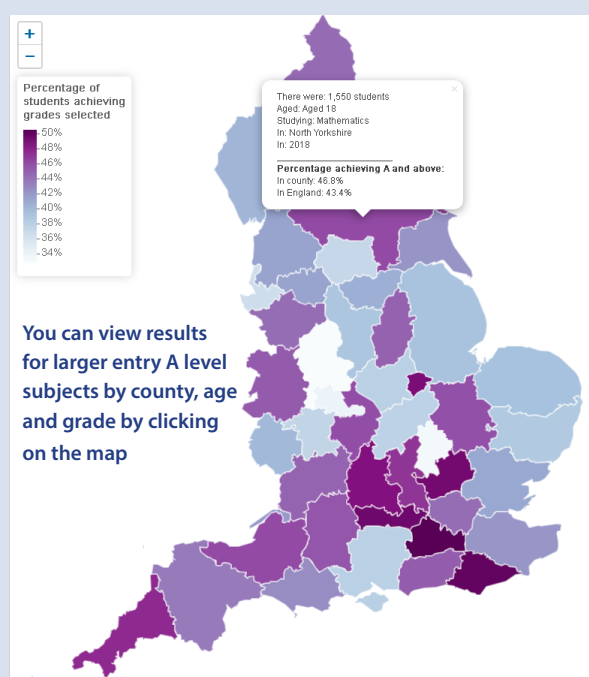
Overall results for 18-year-olds in England continue to exceed those of other ages

A level maths results by county, A*/A, 18-years-old

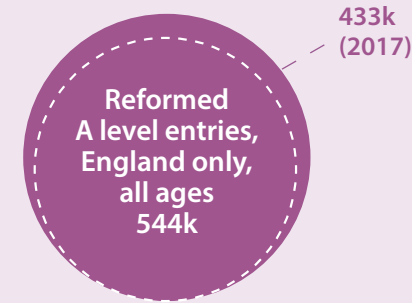

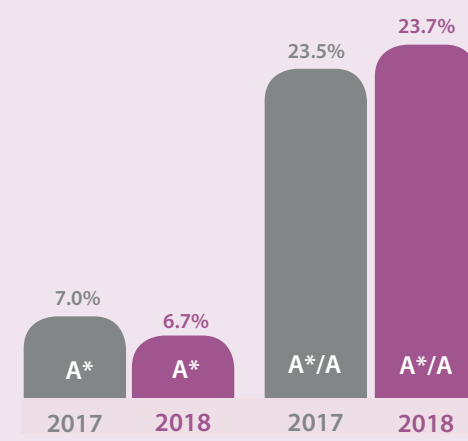
