JUDGMENT

Employment Tribunals Rules of Procedure 2013 – Rule 21

- 1. Miss Bragg was dismissed by reason of redundancy and is entitled to a redundancy payment of £3,422.25.
- 2. The respondent has failed to pay Miss Bragg's holiday entitlement and is ordered to pay her the sum of £527.41 net.
- 3. Miss Bragg's notice pay (breach of contract claim) is dismissed upon withdrawal by her.
- 4. Miss Lawrence was dismissed by reason of redundancy and is entitled to a redundancy payment of £5,755.86.
- 5. The respondent has failed to pay Miss Lawrence's holiday entitlement and is ordered to pay her the sum of £732.64 net.
- 6. Miss Lawrence's notice pay (breach of contract claim) is dismissed upon withdrawal by her.

THE EMPLOYMENT TRIBUNALS (INTEREST) ORDER 1990

The Employment Tribunals (Interest) Order 1990 provides that sums of money payable as a result of a judgment of an Employment Tribunal (excluding sums representing costs or expenses), shall carry interest where the full amount is not paid within 14 days after the day that the document containing the tribunal's written judgment is recorded as having been sent to parties. That day is known as *"the relevant decision day"*. The date from which interest starts to accrue is called *"the calculation day"* and is the day immediately following the relevant decision day.

The rate of interest payable is that specified in section 17 of the Judgments Act 1838 on the relevant decision day. This is known as "the stipulated rate of interest" and the rate applicable in your case is set out below.

The following information in respect of this case is provided by the Secretary of the Tribunals in accordance with the requirements of Article 12 of the Order:-
