Dear All,

I hope you are all well.

During the meetings with the Ambassador and Deputy Ambassador back in March, you all said how useful it would be for an early meeting with the Ministry of Tourism. During his call on the new Minister of Tourism, the Ambassador mentioned this to the Minister, Mrs Selma Elloumi Rekik, and she has expressed a real interest in meeting you all.

We spoke last Friday and I mentioned the proposal and the plan we are putting in place to help ensure that this dialogue is more than a one-off, but is sustained, meaningful and allows both sides to resolve issues of concern in the most appropriate way. The meeting with the Minister will take place at the **Ambassador's residence on Monday 11th May 2015 at 11.00am, followed by a lunch**. We would like to also invite one representative of your Tunisian agents as well. We will leave to you the choice to decide who you would like to invite.

We are also planning to have a pre-meeting (at 10.30 and not 10.00 as per the attached item), similarly to what we did last year, so we can discuss the agenda and possibly appoint a speaker for all subjects or a speaker for each subject/issue.

I attached a document for your views on the proposal, and the agenda items and for more details on the planned meeting. As discussed, we have agreed that the information here will be handled sensitively. We are going to share this proposal with ABTA in London, but we should be grateful that this isn't shared more widely at this stage – once we have engaged the Tunisian side in the idea of sustained dialogue at the meeting then we would expect this proposal to be shaped further by you and the Tunisians.

I would be grateful if you could send me your views/thoughts before the end of this week so we could add them to the agenda.

Looking forward to hearing from you soon and to seeing you all on Monday the 11th May 2015, at 10.30am at the Ambassador's residence.
