JUDGMENT

- 1. The claimant is not a disabled person within the meaning of the Equality Act 2010 in respect of knee damage or his hernia (or, for the avoidance of doubt, his hernia scarring).
- 2. The claimant's claim of failure to make reasonable adjustments arising from damage to his knee was submitted beyond the relevant time limit. It is not just or equitable to extend time and this complaint is dismissed.
