The effect of the Order, if confirmed without modifications, will be to divert that length of Public Footpath number A5 Turvey commencing from a point where it has a junction with that part of Footpath number A5 Turvey to be retained approximately 232 metres north-north-east of the Abbey Farm complex at Ordnance Survey Grid Reference (OSGR) SP 9503/5210 shown as Point A on the order map then running in a generally south-south-easterly then east-northeasterly direction for 580 metres to a point where it has a junction with that part of Public Bridleway number 5 Turvey to be retained approximately 360 metres south-south-east of the Abbey Farm complex at OSGR SP 9525/5165 shown as Point B on the order map to a line commencing from a point where it has a junction with that part of Footpath number A5 Turvey to be retained approximately 232 metres north-northeast of the Abbey Farm complex at OSGR SP 9503/5210 shown as Point A on the order map then running in a generally south-easterly then southerly direction for 532 metres to a point where it has a junction with that part of Public Bridleway number 5 Turvey to be retained approximately 355 metres east-south-east of the Abbey Farm complex at OSGR SP 9529/5174 shown as Point C on the order map.

As soon as possible after the deadline, the Secretary of State will send full copies to the Authority. Copies (excluding copies of any supporting documents - these will be available to view at the Authority's offices) will also be sent to the applicant, every person who has made an objection or representation and any other person who has written to us in respect of the Order.

Within the same period the applicant (if applicable) must ensure their statement of case is received by the Secretary of State. As soon as possible after the deadline, Secretary of State will send a full copy to the Authority. Copies will also be sent to everyone who has made an objection or representation and any other person who has written to us in respect of the Order (excluding copies of any supporting documents - these will be available to view at the Authority's offices).

Within 14 weeks of the start date [by 13 December 2018]

Everyone who has made an objection or representation, the Authority, the applicant (if applicable) and anyone who has written to us in respect of the Order must ensure that their comments on any or every other statement of case is received by the Secretary of State. As soon as possible after the deadline, the Secretary of State will send copies of these comments to everyone else.

Any other person wishing to make representations in writing to the Secretary of State in respect of the above Order must do so in line with the timetable set out above.

THIS ORDER is made by the Bedford Borough Council ("the Authority") under Section 119 of the Highways Act 1980 ("the 1980 Act") because it appears to the Authority that in the interests of the owner of the land crossed by the footpath described in paragraph 1 of this Order it is expedient that the line of the footpath should be diverted.

Mrs Annette Richter, Abbey Farm, Turvey MK43 8DH has agreed to defray any compensation which becomes payable in consequence of the coming into force of this Order and any expenses which are incurred in bringing the new site of the footpath into a fit condition for use by the public.

BY THIS ORDER

- 1. The public right of way over the land situated to the east of the Abbey Farm complex, Jacks Lane, Turvey in the parish of Turvey and shown by a bold continuous line between points A to B on the map attached to this Order and described in Part 1 of the Schedule to this Order shall be stopped up on the date on which Bedford Borough Council certify that work has been carried out to bring the site of the new highway mentioned in Part 2 of the Schedule to this Order into a fit condition for use by the public.
- Notwithstanding paragraph 1 of this Order statutory undertakers shall have the same 2. rights over the land referred to in paragraph 1 above, in respect of their apparatus under, in, upon, over, along or across the said land as they had immediately before the date of confirmation of this Order.
- 3. There shall at the end of 28 (twenty-eight) days from the date of confirmation of this Order be a public footpath over the land situated to the east and north-east of the Abbey Farm complex, Jacks Lane, Turvey in the parish of Turvey as described in Part 2 of the Schedule to this Order and shown by a bold broken line between points A to C on the map attached to this Order.
- 4. This Order may be cited as the, "Bedford Borough Council (Turvey: Part of Footpath No. A5) Public Path Diversion Order 2018".


