## JUDGMENT

- 1. The Claimant's claim that the Respondent failed to pay the Claimant the holiday pay due to her under regulation 14 (2) Working Time Regulations 1998 is well-founded.
- 2. The Respondent is ordered to pay the Claimant £630 holiday pay that is due, subject to the appropriate deductions for tax and National Insurance.
- 3. When these proceedings were begun the Respondent was in breach of the duty to the Claimant to provide written particulars of employment under section 1(1) Employment Rights Act 1996 and it is just and equitable to increase the Claimant's award by £1,260 (4 weeks' pay) as a result.

4. The total award is therefore £1,890 to be paid by the Respondent to the Claimant.
