I, the undersigned, certify that the birds described above meet the following requirements:

- a) being within 24 hours prior to export, I have examined all the birds for export and found no signs of infectious or contagious disease, and in my opinion the birds are fit for the intended journey;
- b) the birds for export have been resident in the UK prior to export which has been officially free from **Avian influenza** (H5 and H7) and **Newcastle disease**;
- c)* the birds have been resident prior to export in premises that have been free of Derzsy viral disease, Avian Tuberculoosis, Cholera, Duck Virus Hepatitis and Ornithosis (Psittacosis) during the last 6 months;
- d) the birds for export, have been held under my supervision in an approved pre-export isolation facility, have not been vaccinated for avian influenza and have been found healthy at individual examination during this period
