I, the undersigned, certify that the birds described above meet the following requirements:

the birds have been resident prior to export in premises that have been free of Derzsy viral disease, Avian Tuberculuosis, cholera, Duck Virus Hepatitis and Ornithosis (Psittacosis) during the last 6 months;
