- 1. A copy of this certificate must be sent to the local Divisional Veterinary Manager (DVM) on the day of issue.
- 2. The test for psittacosis at paragraph IV b) must be carried out within 30 days of shipment.
- 3. The Department disclaimer (Form 372DMR) must be issued to the exporter with this certificate for his/her information. The certificate is provided on the basis of information available at the time and may not necessarily comply fully with the requirements of the importing country. It is the exporter's responsibility to check the certificate against any relevant import permit or any advice provided by the competent authority in the importing country. If these do not match, the exporter should contact the Animal Health (International Trade) Division at the address given below.
