Trained animal technicians examined the mice for physical (b) abnormalities and for clinical signs of infectious or contagious disease within 24 hours of the time that the mice were placed in the shipping container and loaded at the animal facilities stated in paragraph II(b). Mice with physical abnormalities that are characteristic of the specific inbred strain or mutation are considered to be normal and are shipped. The mice originated from indoor barrier-maintained animal facilities (C) stated in paragraph II (b). The facilities are designed to prevent intrusion of wild rodents and insect pests. The mice are Specified-Pathogen-Free (SPF) and come from a colony (d) that is free from contagious ectoparasites, helminth endoparasites and other infectious diseases of laboratory rodents as shown on the animal health monitoring report.
