IV. Health Information

I, the undersigned, certify that the animals described above meet the following requirements:-

- (a) on (date), being within 24 hours of loading, I examined the said animals and found them to be healthy and free from clinical signs of infectious or contagious disease including ectoparasitism;
- (b) in so far as can be determined, and on the basis of a written declaration from the owner*/exporter* the said animals were born in the European Community or have been legally imported into the European Community from a Third country;
- (c) they are not animals which are to be destroyed under a national scheme to eradicate a contagious or infectious disease;
- (d) the said animals have not been vaccinated against foot and mouth disease;
- (e) the premises of origin is situated at the centre of an area of 10 km radius which is free from foot and mouth disease;
- (f) no outbreak of any notifiable disease of livestock has occurred on the premises of origin in the last 30 days;
- (g) the said animals originate from a premises not subject to prohibition as a result of an outbreak of foot and mouth disease during the past 30 days, brucellosis during the past 42 days or of anthrax during the past 15 days;
- (h) the said animals originate from a premises on which there has been no clinical, serological, micro biological or pathological evidence of brucellosis (including *Brucella abortus*, *Brucella melitensis*, *Brucella ovis*) or tuberculosis during the past 42 days;
- (i) a declaration has been received from the exporter*/transporter* stating that the said animals will be moved from the premises of origin to the port of embarkation in vehicles/containers previously cleansed and disinfected with a disinfectant approved by DEFRA and without coming into contact with cloven hoofed animals not similarly certified;

(j) the route from the premises of origin to the port of embarkation does not come within 10 km of any premises where foot and mouth disease has occurred during the past 3 months;
