IV. Health Information

I, the undersigned, being an Official Veterinarian of the United Kingdom hereby certify that:

- (a) on being the last business day preceding export to Canada, to a maximum of 72 hours prior to the intended time of export, I examined the said animal(s) and found it/them to be free from clinical signs of infectious or zoonotic disease and, as far as can be determined, exposure thereto, and in my opinion to be fit to travel without undue suffering by reason of infirmity, illness, injury, fatigue or other cause during the expected journey;
- (b) in so far as can be determined and based on a written declaration from the owner/exporter, the said animal(s) was/were born and raised in captivity and as far as can be determined, has/have not had exposure to wild animals;
- (c) the premises of origin at paragraph II(a) has been free from any clinical or epidemiological evidence of rabies, in the animals on the premises, for a period of 24 months prior to the date of export or any quarantine related to the exportation;
- (d) the premises of origin at paragraph II(a) has been free from clinical, microbiological, pathological or epidemiological evidence of tuberculosis (Mycobacterium bovis) throughout the 36 months immediately prior to export;
- (e) the premises of origin at paragraph II(a) have been free from any clinical or serological evidence of brucellosis for 24 months immediately prior to movement of the animal(s) off the premises;
- (f) the animal(s) has/have not come into contact with any animals, products or equipment of lesser zoosanitary health status during the entire required periods of residency, isolation, storage and transportation to the port of exportation;
- (g) on (date), more than four (4) days and not more than fourteen (14) days prior to export to Canada the said animal(s) was/were treated for external parasites using the following licensed preparation according to the manufacturer's instructions:

- (h) the animal(s) has/have been isolated from all other animals for the period of 14 days immediately prior to exportation to Canada;
- (j) *The attached schedule outlines any treatments or vaccinations (excluding those described at paragraphs IV(g) and IV(h) above) that were administered to the animals for export during the six (6) months immediately preceding export to Canada;

- (k) I have received a written declaration from the owner/exporter that:
 - (i) the animal(s) will not come into contact with any animals, products or equipment of lesser zoosanitary health status during the entire transportation to the port of exportation;
 - (ii) when transport is by air, transportation of the animal(s)
 will be in accordance with the International Air
 Transport Association (IATA) live animals transport
 regulations approved by the Office of International des
 Epizooties (OIE);
 - (iii) for all forms of transport suitable arrangements have been made for the feeding, watering and care of the animal(s) during transportation as far as can be determined;
 - (iv) the animal(s) are not considered to be in an advanced stage of pregnancy, so are not expected to give birth during transportation;
 - (v) any young animals being shipped without a dam have been fully weaned prior to export.
 - (vi) The exporter is aware that the animal(s) for export to Canada must be shipped by the most direct and appropriate route from the point of export to the address of destination in Canada and that transhipment through another country requires written authorization from CFIA.
 - (vii) The animal(s) for export will be transported to the port /airport of departure in containers / vehicles previously cleansed and disinfected with an approved disinfectant and all conveyances (vehicles, containers, or other things) used to transport the qualifying animal(s) and their feed and water from the premises of origin until arrival at the Canadian port of entry have been cleaned and disinfected.
- (1) all conveyances (vehicles, containers, or other things) used to transport the qualifying animal(s) and other things such as feed from the premises of origin were cleaned and disinfected to my satisfaction prior to loading the animal(s) for export.
