I, the undersigned, certify that the birds described above meet the following requirements:

- (a) Highly pathogenic avian influenza (HPAI) is a notifiable disease in the United Kingdom;
- *Either (i) the United Kingdom has been free from HPAI for the past 28 days (b) following a stamping out policy in accordance with Article 10.4.6 of OIE Terrestrial Animal Health Code;
 - (ii) the birds are captive-bred and are not derived from farmed establishments originating from the 10km surveillance zone(s) established around the infected premises in the United Kingdom.
- the birds were not vaccinated against H5 and H7 subtypes of avian influenza, (C) defined by the World Organisation for Animal Health (OIE);
- United Kingdom has been free from velogenic Newcastle Disease for the six (d) months immediately prior to export;
- the birds for export were kept in isolation in a facility approved by the Government veterinary authority since they were hatched or for at least 28 (e) days prior to shipment and showed no clinical signs of infectious diseases including avian influenza during the isolation period;
- during the isolation period above, all birds, or a sample of birds from one consignment were subject to the following tests within 14 days prior to (f) export:
 - *Either (i) a virus isolation test for avian influenza with negative results in each case. The sample size should not be fewer than 30 birds. (Pooling is permitted with not more than 10 samples in each pool);
