- I, the undersigned, official veterinarian, declare that:
  - a) I have examined the animals and them found to be healthy and free from any clinical signs of infectious or contagious disease that the animals are susceptible to(including ectoparasites), at the time of export;
  - b) the United Kingdom is free from Foot-and-Mouth Disease, Rinderpest, Contagious Bovine Pleuropneumonia, Peste des petits ruminants, and Contagious Caprine Pleuropneumonia for at least 12 months prior to export and no vaccination against these diseases is permitted in the country;
  - c) the animals came from an establishment in which infectious and contagious animal diseases are under control and where no case of trypanosomiasis, anaplasmosis, Johnne's disease, rabies, leptospirosis or brucellosis has occurred in the last 3 months prior to export;
  - d) I have received a declaration from the exporter that the animals have been kept in captivity in the country of export for at least 6 months prior to export or since birth;

- e) the animals have not been vaccinated with any vaccine within 30 days of export.
