I, the undersigned, certify that the birds described above meet the following requirements:

- a) I have this day inspected the said birds and found them to be free from clinical signs of infectious or contagious diseases including avian influenza and psittacosis, free from external parasites, and fit to travel;
- b) as far as can be determined there has been no clinical or pathological evidence of the following diseases at the premises of origin at paragraph II. (b) during the 6 months prior to export: highly pathogenic avian influenza (HPAI), Newcastle disease, fowl typhoid (*Salmonella gallinarum*), epidemic tremor (avian infectious encephalomyelitis), bacillary white diarrhoea (*Salmonella pullorum*), Gumboro disease and Mareck's disease;
- c) during the 30 days prior to export, no case of notifiable highly pathogenic avian influenza or Newcastle disease has been confirmed within a radius of 25 kilometres of the premises of origin, and the area is not subject to any restrictions due to these notifiable diseases.
