FOI request, M25 Speed Cameras

I am writing to confirm that we have now completed our search for the information, which you requested on 12 September 2018. You have asked us to provide the following information:

Data for speed cameras found along the M25 carriageway with both directions being listed separately between Hertfordshire/Watford until Junction 2 in Kent (including Essex).

For ease I have answered each of your questions in order:

1. Where is the speed cameras/average/traffic monitoring cameras found along the M25, clockwise and anticlockwise?

Please find below a list of speed cameras present on the M25 as of the 21 August 2018.

Please note, we have no average speed cameras on the M25.

2. Of these cameras, how many vehicles were caught speeding in the years 2014, 2015, 2016, 2017 and 2018, for each direction?

Please note we are not an Enforcement Authority. Therefore, as this part of your request relates to speed enforcement, this information can only be confirmed with the relevant police force for the area you are interested in.

Our records are kept for operational purposes, not speed enforcement and should be considered for information only.

3. Each year broken down, how much speeding notices were sent out for the years and directions above? how many in numbers and in monies?

4. How many of these notices were paid in the first notice (year by year)? How much is this in monies?

5. How much in monies, was the total value from speeding fines/notices for each of these years for these areas (year by year)?

6. How many drivers appealed their speeding notices each year?

7. How many of these appeals were granted year by year?
