

Addendum to certificate number:  
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**Section C: To be signed at the transit port by the Official Government Veterinarian<sup>i</sup>**

I, the undersigned Official Government Veterinarian of \_\_\_\_\_ (EU Member State where in-transit stop occurs), hereby certify that:

1. The zoological ruminant(s)\* described in the above reference health certificate arrived at the transit port in an officially sealed means of conveyance.
2. No livestock, other than those intended for export to the United States, were aboard the means of conveyance that transported the zoological ruminant(s)\* to the in-transit port, or shared the same airspace with it/them\*.
3. The animal(s)\* were isolated during their transit stop and no other livestock or animals capable of transmitting diseases were present in the building which housed the animal(s)\* during the transit stop.
4. No warehouse, equipment or materials used during the transit stop was previously used for other livestock that do not meet the above requirements, unless the warehouse, equipment or materials were first cleaned and disinfected.
5. The transporting aircraft or vessel embarking from the in-transit port was cleaned and disinfected prior to loading.
6. The seal on the crate was intact prior to loading onto the transporting vessel/aircraft.
7. No livestock, other than those intended for export to the United States, are aboard the transporting aircraft or vessel embarking to the United States.
8. The captain or transport carrier has been informed of the transportation requirements described in this Section and Section B.
