- \*d) **IN THE CASE OF PSITTACINES ONLY**  
whilst in isolation, the bird(s) intended for export was/were treated against psittacosis/ornithosis using chlortetracycline in accordance with the manufacturer's recommendations;
- e) the premises of origin are free from Newcastle disease and highly pathogenic avian influenza (fowl plague) and are not situated in an area subject to restriction due to these diseases.
