- b) They are derived from parent flocks which have not been vaccinated against avian influenza;

 - (i) were examined on the date of issue of this certificate and showed no clinical signs or grounds for suspecting any diseases;
 - (ii) have been kept for at least 6 weeks immediately prior to this export to Albania at the establishment(s) in paragraph II(b) above which are officially approved in accordance with Annex II of Directive 2009/158/EC; and
 - the approval has not been suspended or withdrawn;
 - they are not subject to animal health restrictions;
 - (iii) during the 6 weeks mentioned in sub-paragraph (ii) above, have had no contact with poultry not complying with the requirements laid down in this certificate or with wild birds;
 - (iv) have undergone a disease surveillance programme for Salmonella pullorum, S.gallinarum, S.arizonae, Mycoplasma gallisepticum, and M. meleagridis in accordance with Chapter III of Annex II of Directive 2009/158/EC and were not found to be infected, nor showed any grounds for suspecting any infection, by these agents;
