I, the undersigned, certify that the birds comprising the flock(s) of origin meet the following requirements:

- a) They have remained on the territory of the United Kingdom (UK) for at least the past 3 months. Where the flocks from which the hatching eggs come were imported into the UK this took place in accordance with veterinary conditions at least as strict as the relevant requirements of Directive 2009/158/EC and any subsidiary decisions;
- b) They have had no epidemiological link to an establishment where avian influenza has been detected within the last 30 days;
- c) They have not been vaccinated against avian influenza;
- d) They:

(i) have been kept for at least 6 weeks immediately prior to this export to Albania at the establishment(s) in paragraph II(b) above which are officially approved in accordance with Annex II of Directive 2009/158/EC; and

- the approval has not been suspended or withdrawn;

- they are not subject to animal health restrictions;

(ii) during the 6 weeks mentioned in sub-paragraph (ii) above, have had no contact with poultry not complying with the requirements laid down in this certificate or with wild birds;

	(iii) have undergone a disease surveillance programme forSalmonella pullorum, S.gallinarum, S.arizonae, Mycoplasma gallisepticum, and M. meleagridis * in accordance with Chapter III of Annex II of Directive 2009/158/EC and were not found to be infected, nor showed any grounds for suspecting any infection, by these agents;
