- c) the United Kingdom has been free from Eastern and Western equine encephalomyelitis for the last 2 years;
- Glanders is a notifiable disease in the United Kingdom and no case has been reported during the past 3 years;
- e) the United Kingdom has been free from trypanomome evansi (Surra) for the past 12 months;
- f) the United Kingdom has been free from rabies in the past 2 years;
- g) no case of Hendra-virus infection has been reported in horses in the United Kingdom during the last 3 months;
- h) no case of Nipah virus infection has been reported in horses in the United Kingdom for the last 2 years;

 - (xix) West nile virus infection;
 - (xx) Glanders;
