IV. Health information

I, the undersigned, certify that the birds described above meet the following requirements:

- a) I have this day inspected the said birds and found them to be free from clinical signs of infectious or contagious disease and fit to travel;
- b) on (date), being within 28 days of the intended date of export, the birds comprising the flock(s) of origin were inspected and found to be free from clinical signs of infectious or contagious disease;
- c) in so far as can be determined, there has been no clinical or pathological evidence of the following diseases on the premises of origin during the past 6 months: fowl cholera, ornithosis, Marek's disease, avian leukosis, infectious laryngotracheitis, infectious bronchitis or infectious avian encephalomyelitis;
- d) The flock(s) of origin and the hatchery(ies) are located in
EITHER*
- i) the United Kingdom which is free of highly pathogenic avian influenza (HPAI);
OR
- ii) a HPAI free zone of the United Kingdom;
OR
- iii) a HPAI free poultry compartment of the United Kingdom;
- e) In case the consignment originates from an avian influenza free compartment, all flock(s) and hatchery(ies) of origin are approved as part of the compartment and their compartment approval numbers are listed under II.b of this certificate. The compartment complies with relevant norms and guidelines stipulated by the OIE Terrestrial Animal Health Code.*
- f) The flock(s) of origin of the day old chicks described above have been subjected to AGID or ELISA testing for avian influenza with negative results within 30 days of the date of export;
- g) no outbreak of Newcastle disease has been confirmed on the

premises of origin, or the hatchery, or within a radius of 10 kms thereof during the past 3 months;

h) The source flocks have not been vaccinated against avian influenza;

*j) **FOR NON-POULTRY HEALTH SCHEME FLOCKS:**
blood samples have been taken from all the birds comprising the flock of origin and subjected to the rapid plate agglutination test for pullorum disease and fowl typhoid, with negative results in each case.

*k) **FOR POULTRY HEALTH SCHEME FLOCKS:**
the flock(s) of origin and the hatchery are members of the Government supervised Poultry Health Scheme and are considered free of Salmonella pullorum (pullorum disease) and Salmonella gallinarum (fowl typhoid);
