I, the undersigned Official Veterinarian of the United Kingdom, certify that the chicken hatching eggs described above meet the following requirements:

- a) The establishments of origin of the birds/eggs are members of a Government supervised poultry health scheme and are under regular supervision by the veterinary authorities of the United Kingdom;
- b) there has been no history or clinical evidence of the following diseases in the establishments of origin during the past 3 months prior to export: avian influenza, Newcastle disease, Salmonella pullorum (Pullorum disease), Salmonella gallinarum (Fowl typhoid), infectious bronchitis, mycoplasmosis and avian chlamydiosis;
- c) The eggs were derived from parent birds that were resident for at least 21 days before, and throughout, egg collection in EITHER (i)* the UK OR (ii)* a zone within the UK OR (iii)*a Compartment within the UK

which was free from Avian Influenza as defined in the OIE Code;

- d) The eggs were derived from parent birds that were resident for at least 21 days before, and throughout, egg collection in EITHER (i)* the UK OR (ii)* a zone within the UK OR (iii)* a zone within the UK which was free from Newcastle disease as defined in the OIE Code;
- e) the parent flocks of the eggs have not been treated or fed with any natural or synthetic hormonal substances, antibiotics or toxic substances which are internationally contraindicated or exceed European Union maximum permitted levels;
- f) the hatching eggs were collected hygienically sanitized as soon as possible after collection using an approved product according to the manufacturer's instructions;
- g) the hatching eggs were packed directly into clean, new and unused disposable boxes for export and are being transported in sealed containers and in accordance with the biosecurity procedures in poultry production of the OIE.
