- c) in so far as can be determined there has been no clinical evidence of highly pathogenic avian influenza (fowl plague), Newcastle disease, fowl cholera, Salmonella pullorum, Salmonella gallinarum, Mycoplasma gallisepticum and fowl pox on the premises of origin during the 90 days prior to export;
- d) in so far as can be determined and based on information provided in a written declaration received from the owner/exporter, the day old chickens have*/have not* been vaccinated against Marek's disease using a licenced product in accordance with the manufacturer's instructions;
- e) the flock(s) of origin and hatchery are members of the Government supervised Poultry Health Scheme and are considered free from Salmonella pullorum and Salmonella gallinarum;
- f) no outbreak of highly pathogenic avian influenza (fowl plague) or Newcastle disease have been confirmed at the premises of origin or the hatchery, or within a radius of 10 km thereof, during the past 90 days.
